ENDANGERED AFRICAN PENGUINS FIND SOME R&R IN PLETTENBERG BAY

At any given time throughout the year, endangered African penguins can be found along the Indian Ocean coastline of Plettenberg Bay. For many, it is not always fun and games in the water and sometimes they require immediate assistance. Assistance in the form of rehabilitation of the birds varies. Mostly birds that require assistance in Plett are either sick, injured, moulting or have what is referred to as "flat battery syndrome". Penguins can be affected by a range of illnesses, but the ones most often encountered locally appear to be babesia, a tick-borne blood parasite, and avian malaria. Injuries range from minor cuts and scrapes that may affect mobility or waterproofing of feathers, to more serious wounds inflicted by either other animals, or by entanglements or boat propellers. Moulting birds come ashore to grow a new set of feathers, during which time they cannot swim as their waterproofing is affected. Being on the mainland means exposure to predators, both natural and companion animals, so birds are safely kept in captivity until their moult is finished. The flat battery cases are often down to bad body condition (underweight) and dehydration – they just need some TLC to get back on track and that's where Tenikwa Wildlife Rehabilitation Centre comes to the

Once rehabilitated the town celebrates with a release of penguins which have completed their rehabilitation and relaxation journey – R&R. Through the combined efforts of Tenikwa, Natures Valley Trust, local veterinarian specialists, the Bitou Municipality and Plett Tourism, the releases take place throughout the year, on average once every 2-3 months

Tenikwa microchips every bird that is released, which enables them to track if a particular individual comes back into rehab, is located by researchers at one of the breeding colonies or washes up dead on our shore. The Natures Valley Team has a mobile scanner and try to scan every dead penguin reported to them. In addition to the rehabilitation team at Tenikwa, local veterinarian specialists are also present when the penguins are released. ties from the Bitou Municipality are also key stakeholders who help facilitate the process. And the team at Plett Tourism provide a live -stream platform for overseas and local viewing of the release.

Sadly, not every penguin that comes into rehab can or will be able to be released back into the wild. Tenikwa has a few long-term captives that are a permanent part of their animal collection, and that play an important role in educating the public about these beautiful birds. Others sadly succumb to their illnesses or injuries.

The latest release on Saturday the 20th of March encouraged Plett locals and a few visitors to make their way down to Lookout Beach to witness the release, this is one of Plett's premier Blue Flag beaches.

Collection from Guest House in Summer-Strand P.E between 06h00 - 06h30

Duration of Game Drive 07h00 - 12h00 We enter the Park through the Addo Colchester Gate, Camp Matyholweni. The first few hours are good to see antelope, zebra and some of the cats. Between 09h00 and 09h30 we serve a delicious continental breakfast in the picnic area. Usually one has good sightings of elephants and buffalo after 10h00 nearer the waterholes. We return to the Gate around 12h00 and then back to the Guest House. Refreshments are available throughout the drive.

AFTERNOON GAME DRIVE

Collection from Guest House in Summer-Strand P.E between 13h00 - 13h30

Duration of Game Drive 14h00 - 18h00 We enter the Park through the Addo Colchester Gate, Camp Matyholweni. The early afternoon is good for elephant and buffalo sightings, near the water holes, as well as some antelope and zebra. We stop mid-afternoon at a disembarkment point or picnic area for teas, coffee, refreshments, scones and snacks. The latter part of the afternoon is usually good for antelope and the illusive rhino. The Park has thick bush and offers an abundance of birds, tortoise, dung beetles and other creatures.

South African Animal Sanctuaries Alliance, April, 2021 Innovative campaign will transfer

control of land to the animals that live in this award-winning primate sanctuary near Plettenberg Bay.

\$5 (R90) buys land for Plett's primates in a move that could be the first of its kind, Monkeyland has asked its supporters to help the animals in its care to buy the land on which they live in order to secure their own future.

"The crisis in tourism caused by the current pandemic has opened our eyes to the possibility that future generations of shareholders might not have the same passion for the animals that we do," said Tony Blignaut, the sanctuary's founder and CEO. He explained that, while Monkeyland operates on land belonging to a proprietary limited company, the welfare of its animals remains the responsibility of the South African Animal Sanctuaries Alliance (SAASA) -- a PBO and non-profit organisation that also oversees the wellbeing of the residents of Birds of Eden and Jukani Wildlife Sanctuary in Plettenberg Bay, and MonkeylandKZN in South Africa's KwaZulu-Natal Province

"If future generations of shareholders don't feel as passionately as we do, there's nothing stopping them from selling off the land for development, and leaving the animals with nowhere to go," he said. MONKEYLAND: THE DREAM

When Monkeyland opened its gates to the public in April, 1998, the founders saw their role as providing a safe environment where previously captive primates -- monkeys, lemurs, gibbons -- could live out their lives in comfort and relative freedom, and in conditions under which they're able to find their own companions and mates, and form their own family groups (if that's in their nature). mGiven that the primates held here originated mostly from the pet trade, and since they aren't indigenous to South Africa, it wasn't practical to release them locally into the wild. But the alarming rate of habitat destruction around the world has added a second focus to Monkeyland's purpose: to protect the future of the species in its care in the event they're needed for repopulating natural wildlands. ("We will not under any circumstances trade any creature with private individuals, zoos or institutions unless it's for reintroduction into the wild," said Mr. Blignaut.)

Achieving these lofty ideals -- and, indeed, simply meeting the day-to-day needs of the animals -- is, of course, a costly business, which is why tourism has always been a

vital part of the Monkeyland formula: the income it generates keeps the animals fed and in good health.

Or it did before the pandemic hit. AWARD WINNING SANCTUARIES The idea of being able to see wild animals close at hand without actually interacting with them proved a winner for visitors and animals alike, and as a result, Monkeyland and the South African Animals Sanctuary Alliance have featured prominently in an array of awards for responsible tourism and sustainable tourism -- including, most recently, being named the Leading Major Tourist Attraction in Skål International's 2019 Sustainable Tourism Awards. https:// www.skal.org/sta-winners/2019-2

LAND FOR PRIMATES 'Having set the bar as high as we have, we felt we had to find a way to ensure we don't falter -- and one way to do this is literally to give the animals rights over their own land," šaid Mr. Blignaut.

"And we'll do this by putting those rights in

trust with SAASA.

To achieve this aim, the owners of the farm have agreed to sell the land to SAASA, and SAASA in turn has set up its 'Buy a square metre of land for primates' campaign so that members of the public can help fund the purchase by donating as little as a single square metre to the cause - at a cost of only \$5 (or R 90.00) per square metre. (See map at https://www.monkeyland.tv/map/) "With a total of 216,000 square metres available, the campaign will raise more than the required amount, and the balance will go into an emergency fund to protect the animals' food bill until such time as tourism returns to normal," said Mr. Blignaut. Since SAASA has both PBO and NPO registration numbers, donations are tax
