Collection from Guest House in Summer-Strand P.E between 06h00 - 06h30

Duration of Game Drive 07h00 - 12h00 We enter the Park through the Addo Colchester Gate, Camp Matyholweni. The first few hours are good to see antelope, zebra and some of the cats. Between 09h00 and 09h30 we serve a delicious continental breakfast in the picnic area. Usually one has good sightings of elephants and buffalo after 10h00 nearer the waterholes. We return to the Gate around 12h00 and then back to the Guest House. Refreshments are available throughout the drive.

AFTERNOON GAME DRIVE

Collection from Guest House in Summer-Strand P.E between 13h00 - 13h30

Duration of Game Drive 14h00 - 18h00 We enter the Park through the Addo Colchester Gate, Camp Matyholweni. The early afternoon is good for elephant and buffalo sightings, near the water holes, as well as some antelope and zebra. We stop mid-afternoon at a disembarkment point or picnic area for teas, coffee, refreshments, scones and snacks. The latter part of the afternoon is usually good for antelope and the illusive rhino. The Park has thick bush and offers an abundance of birds, tortoise, dung beetles and other creatures.

APPLES OF GOLD in a setting of silver-Proverbs 25v11

Today as promised, we consider Part 3 of the 8th Commandment; 'You shall not Steal'. We will look at three attitudes that will counter the temptation to take what does not belong to us. 1. Hate Greed. Greed often leads to theft! I grew up with a friend whose father was the CEO of a company that served most of Africa with raw material for the building industry. They lived in a beautiful home up on the mountain side, drove the best cars and spent a good part of the year travelling the world. On a given day, a team of investigators arrived at their home only to find the ceiling of the double garage stocked with thousands of rolls of toilet paper that the Father had stolen from the company. It's a bizarre story, but clearly illustrates the nature of Greed. It usually ends up making NO SENSE as to why people want more and the lengths they will go to to get more. In 1 Tim 6:6 Paul gives perspective. 'Godliness with Contentment is Great gain'. 2.Love Giving.

When Rockefeller ended up in a mental hospital, having gotten to what seemed like the end of the road, a good friend said to him; 'Sir, up to now, you have made every human effort to get more and more. 



Africa's leading beach destinations Plett, hit hard by Covid restrictions, particularly beach closures.

Plettenberg Bay's hospitality industry estimates that the town lost in excess R674 million in tourism earnings between the months of October, November and December 2020 as the tourism industry experienced the cancellation of Plett Rage. the closure of their beaches and the ban on alcohol sales in hotels and restaurants Earlier in the year, restrictions on travel to combat COVID-19 reduced airline incoming travel and accelerated accommodation cancellations. These measures continue to affect the sector, reducing international inflows, and impacting the service sector-related employment with a high dependence on tourism.

The sector is undoubtedly the leading source of income for Plettenberg Bay, generating an average of R3.9 billion in earnings annually pre-COVID. Tourism contributes significantly to Plett's annual

GDP and it is the largest employer in the town. As a world-class destination, international and South African guests flock to their award-winning and internationally recognised beaches. The South African domestic market (South African travellers) makes up approximately 90% of the sector's income during the month of December, and the majority of businesses in Plett rely on that December trade to sustain them, as it contributes to an average of 50% of their annual profit.

South Africans were very keen to travel during the traditional December summer holidays. Beach destinations throughout South Africa were positioned to host South Africans during those few weeks in large numbers, with their survival largely dependent upon those guests. The small coastal holiday towns like Plett were hit with an additional crippling blow when the South African government announced the ban on their beaches resulting in many cancellations.

The bookings for accommodation in Plett during the period leading up to the

December- January period exceeded expectations and Plett was anticipating a relatively high occupancy rate for that period but when the beaches were closed, the negative impact was immediate with a 30% cancellation rate and then an additional 40% in cancellations with the extension of the beach closure.

JOB LOSSES

According to data collected through Plett Tourism's quarterly survey, which included the peak summer season, at least 1,096 jobs in the hospitality industry were affected over the course of three months as accommodation, restaurants and tour operator activities recorded extremely low business turnover.

The accommodation sector reported temporary staff losses of 372 and permanent staff losses of 222.

The restaurant sector reported temporary staff losses of 98 and permanent staff losses of 294. The tour operator activity sector reported temporary staff losses of 61 and permanent staff losses of 49.

The town experienced up to 70% cancelations due to the beach closures which contributed massively to the job losses.

FINANCIAL LOSS

Financially, the accommodation sector was hit hard with 97% of businesses surveyed reporting a loss. In comparing the months of October, November and December of 2019 to 2020, 50% of survey respondents in 2019 reported an occupancy of greater than 70%. In comparison, only 2% of survey respondents in 2020 reported an occupancy of greater than 70%. Sadly, the majority of respondents for 2020 had an occupancy of less than 50%.

Based on Plett Tourism's survey results, the accommodation industry in Plett realised revenue of approximately R1.35 Billion between the months of October – December in 2019. In comparison, for the same period in 2020, revenue of approximately R674 Million was realised which constituted a loss of 50%.

The restaurant sector saw an average loss of greater than 50% due and the tour operator activity sector saw an average loss of greater than 70%.

of greater than 70%.

"The financial loss to the tourism sector in Plett due to the beach closure announcement by the SA government was devastating. We have lost in excess R674 million in just these past three months. An extremely large chunk of that due to cancellations resulting from the beach closures," said Patty Butterworth, CEO Plett Tourism. "We are encouraging and inviting South African travellers to visit our region during the coming year to enjoy our beautiful beaches, warm hospitality and natural attractions.

We are open for business."

The pandemic continues to hit hard, Domestic tourism is helping, at least partially, to soften the blow. Encouraging news on vaccines has boosted hopes for recovery but challenges remain, with the sector expected to remain in survival mode for quite some the LCEO.
