HUMPBACK WHALE

(*Megaptera novaeangliae*)

KEEP YOUR DISTANCE

50 METRES
300 METRES (IF CALVES ARE PRESENT)

IDENTIFICATION

- A small dorsal fin on top of a prominent hump on its back.
- Long pectoral fins measuring 1/3rd of its body length.
- A jagged edge to their tail flukes.

APPROACH CAREFULLY

Approaches must be **parallel** with the whale.

Do not approach from the rear or head of the whale.

SHOW RESPECT

Let the whale guide the nature of the encounter. **Do not** encircle, separate or chase the animals. If harassment indicators are shown such as evasive swimming and diving, leave the encounter at a slow speed.

THEIR POPULATION SIZE IS CLASSIFIED AS

LEAST CONCERN

However, a smaller west coast sub-population is **VULNERABLE**.

A MATTER OF TIME

The maximum time you can stay with them on a permitted trip is **20 minutes**.

BE AWARE

Humpback whales are known to sometimes display aerial and social behaviours such as **breaching** and **tail slapping**. They are also often **travelling** on their migration route. If you are with a travelling whale ensure you **do not chase** them if they increase their speed away from you. Keep your distance and remain aware of their unique behaviours to ensure safety.

APPLES OF GOLD in a setting of silver-Proverbs 25v11

I trust that those who have been following this series on the Beatitudes [Matthew 5] have been blessed, encouraged and no doubt, challenged. Today we consider the 4th Beatitude. **Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled.** Righteousness firstly speaks about our position and relationship with God. 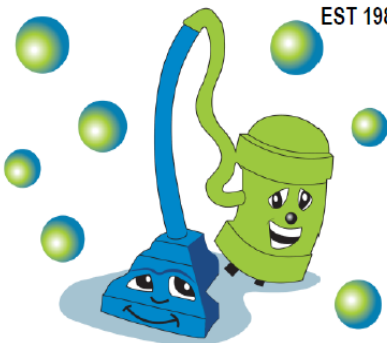

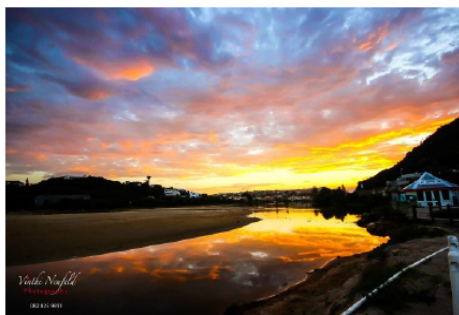

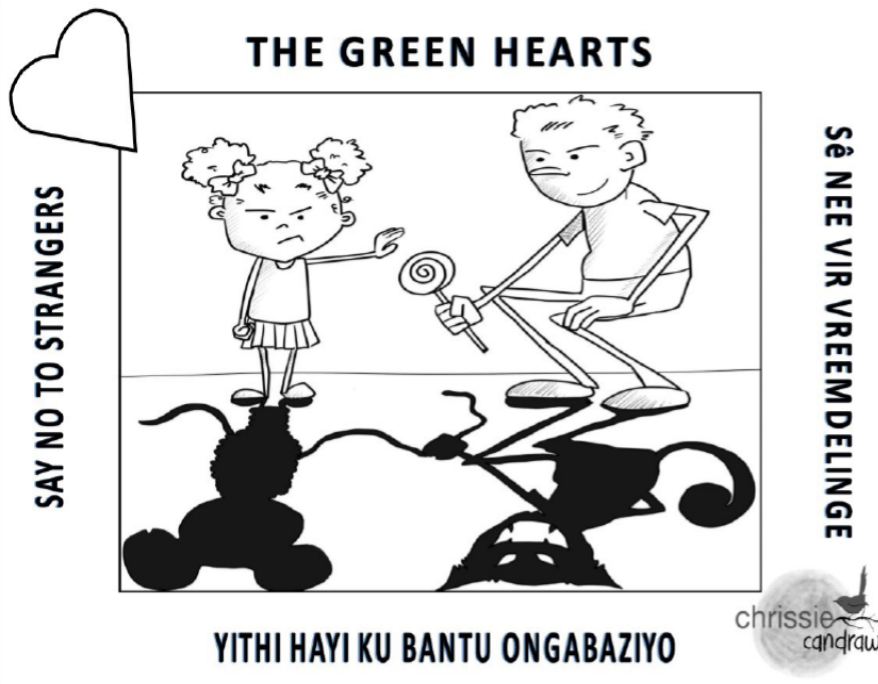

International Compost Awareness Week
Today marks the end of the International
Compost Awareness Week (ICAW). We
would like to share the first month's results
on several items including Plastic cups;
Paper cups; Plastic straws; Paper straws;
Bio straws; Plastic knives; Wooden knives;
Corn-starch bags; and Compostable
"Plastic" bags which were buried at three
WESSA Eco-schools.

February was filled with sunshine and some
sparse rain over a couple of days that was
expected to have negligible effects on the
buried contents. On the 3rd of March 2020,
the first month's contents were removed,
cleaned off, and weighed in comparison to
the original item weights.

We noticed that paper items had broken

down greatly, however, they retained a lot
of moisture from the soils. Weights from the
other materials showed a slight increase in
weight averaging at 0.3g per item, which is
accounted for by soil particles remaining in
grooves of the items. Images below show
the start of the breakdown of paper and
wood materials. Interestingly, the
cornstarch bag increased in weight not by
dirt but by the increase of fungal activity
which is what will eventually breakdown the
bag. This was a very interesting first result
of the project which only grows with the
following months. We know it might take
years for the biodegradable "plastic" bag to
breakdown, it is interesting to see how
organic materials such as the paper and
wood items already in one month of burial
have had some form of break down.
Although this project is making the
comparison to burial (AKA litter) and
composting processes, it is important to see
how these various items degrade in the
environment around us and the rate at
which it breaks down. Unfortunately, we
had to put the project on hold, due to the
nation-wide lockdown. We will continue with
the project, once schools re-opens.

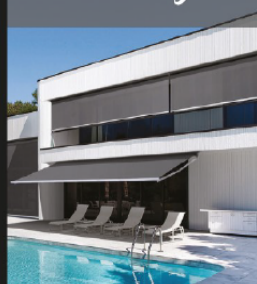

Covid - 19

Level 4 Restrictions
and Moving Towards the
Restoration of our Economy
Dear Plett Residents

No doubt the Covid-19 lock down has come as a massive shock to all of you but none more so than those who either own a business or otherwise earn a living in the Bitou area. The extension of the lock down for a further 2-week period has undoubtedly caused even more concern but in many ways the most frightening aspect of the entire exercise is yet to come and that is re-entering the work place with great concern as to what you will find when you get there. In many ways it will be a bit like re-entering an area after a natural disaster. Nothing will be the same. If it was back to business as usual, some hard work and determination would soon rectify the interruption in momentum and income but, sadly, it is not going to be like that. Even if your business was permitted to open on Friday 1st May, many businesses upon whom you depend for your turnover may not be permitted to operate as yet as a result of which you may be facing similar expenses with a lesser income.

For employees this may mean that you will be made redundant or your salary reduced if that has not happened to you already. To add to the challenges, our most important industry, being the tourism industry, will have been the industry most severely impacted upon and the most challenging to resuscitate as historically we have been very dependent on inbound tourism which tourists are subject to restrictions of their own. As an inevitable knock on effect, many other businesses depend on tourism and will be negatively impacted. The question is "where do we go from here?"

Clearly re-inventing the way we do business and moving as rapidly as we can towards level 1 and beyond must be first and foremost in our minds.

Shortly before the President's address to the nation when announcing the extension of the lockdown, an eminent doctor was interviewed who brought valuable perspective to the predicament faced by the country. In essence he said two very important things.

The first was that the initial predictions concerning the spread and potential impact of the Coronavirus were just that – predictions in the absence of any real scientific data as the virus had so recently appeared on the scene. I believe that we are already seeing that some of the more dire predictions have not come to pass including those pertaining to the spread and impact of the virus in South Africa. At this point in time we are way behind predicted

levels of spread and we share this in common with most of the rest of the world. This is encouraging but by no means any reason for complacency which leads directly into the second and most important point and that is:

"What will happen depends on what we do – or don't do"

In short, the spread and impact of the disease is in the hands of the individual and all of us cooperatively as a town comprising of individuals – each one of us acting sensibly and diligently doing what we are being instructed to do.

Whether you are a businessman desperately striving to save your business or a retired person wondering when you will be able to once again enjoy a cup of coffee with your friends at a coffee shop or get your hair done, the answer is the same. We are all in this together.

If we all pull together and make maximum effort as a town, we should be able to move quite rapidly back to relative normality with most businesses opening so that we can commence the restoration process.

Conversely if there are those amongst us who, for one reason or another, believe that the laid down protocols do not apply to them, we will walk a far longer, harder and less pleasant road with a far more severe impact on our economy. It is as simple as that.

Diligently wearing an adequate facial mask is increasingly being recognized as the key to any strategy to contain the spread of the virus. Germany, which has traditionally shunned masks like many other countries to their cost, have legislated the wearing of masks as part of their strategy to re-open the economy. As an indication of how seriously the Germans now take this issue, a fine of up to US\$5000.00 can be imposed on those failing to comply. From the 1st May the law will require all of us to wear face masks at all times when in a public place. It is up to all businesses and each one of us to ensure that every individual in our town wears a mask at all relevant times. No individual should be admitted to business premises or be engaged in conversation unless wearing a mask. A common practice that has been observed is pulling down one's mask when talking. Talking spreads droplets and is a "high risk of spread" occupation so a mask should not only be worn but in place at all times.

Moving back to normality will also have its challenges because once we are heading there, we will have more visitors visiting our town whilst we are striving to preserve that relative normality. At present we have zero active Covid cases in the Bitou area and no new cases have been detected for some weeks despite extensive testing in some areas. We must strive to keep it that way by not only practicing recommended guidelines diligently but insisting that those that visit our town do likewise.

Insofar as businesses are concerned, you not only need to have in place the full raft of protocols in active use but insist that those that enter your premises adhere to those protocols by having their hands sanitized and wearing a mask at all times.

A recent review of supermarkets and other

businesses currently open revealed a high degree of non-compliance with recommended guidelines and carelessness in implementation even when protocols were in place. Amongst these non-compliance issues were the following:- Staff not in possession of masks – plastic shields are no substitute for a mask but can be used in addition to a mask for additional protection; Staff (and management) in possession of a mask but the mask strung around the neck or otherwise not properly in place; Ineffective hand cleansing facilities at the entrance.
