Keep Plett Clean started twelve years ago to make sure our town looked clean and inviting to tourists and holidaymakers. This would encourage people to buy properties here, holiday here, open businesses and create employment for our people. Accommodation establishments, businesses, restaurants and retail stores would benefit. We have a number of volunteers who have walked this road with us from the beginning, and have helped to make it the success it has become.

This has been achieved by creating awareness and ownership of our surroundings and in so doing, teaching our children not to litter. Not only does littering make our town ugly, but it affects the environment negatively.

As we have grown, we recognised the need for some permanent staff and we now have three very capable hardworking men that are employed by us.

With this growth, our overheads have increased. Duncan Brown from Beacon Isle Kwikspar and Tops has been our main sponsor through the years and has also paid our employees wages every month. We salute you, Duncan Brown, for your kindness and generosity.

We thank Sotheby's for sponsoring all our dog poop bags, Robberg Fine Foods for cleaning the Industrial Area (a business hub that should be serviced daily) once a week, Broll Market Square for the donations and last but by no means least, the few individuals that donate to us monthly. We really appreciate your generosity.

We meet every Tuesday evening for an hour to clean up identified areas.

Keep Plett Clean has a branch in Keurbooms, run by Alan Jackson. They meet to clean fortnightly. MAD - Make A Difference Plett, and Adopt-A-Park fall under our umbrella.

We donate bibs to the car guards so that they are identifiable and neat looking.

We are tasked with keeping Main Street painted and the flower beds neat and clean and the trees and bushes trimmed - thank you to Seeff Properties for helping us with this.

Our expenses have increased as we have grown - we have a scooter that is driven by one of our staff members, which needs to be repaired and maintained, along with the expense of other sundries.

All donations and funds we receive for the various branches are kept in one bank account. We have a full committee, as well as a registered NPO. Our account is audited by an accountant.

Marine Wildlife Strandings in the Garden
Route.

If, while enjoying your time on the beach
and shoreline, you encounter a stranded
species of marine wildlife, please contact
your local Marine Stranding organization.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU FIND A TURTLE.

1) Do not return it to the ocean. It has
stranded as it is either weak, ill, tired or has
ingested plastic. 2) Do not place it in a
container of water. Turtles are air breathing
and can drown if weak and tired. 3) Keep
it in a dry, ventilated and room temperature
box, preferably placing the turtle on a
towel. 4) Contact the turtle rescue number
or the local marine stranding organization.

5) Get a location pin

WHAT TO DO IF YOU FIND A LIVE SEAL.

1) Do not try and chase it into the water - it
is either tired, undernourished or weak and
wants to rest. 2) Create a safe zone
around it and prevent dogs and crowds
from approaching it. 3) Call your local

4) Take a location pin to share with the
rescuers.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU FIND A PENGUIN

1) Do not try and chase it into the water - it
is either tired, undernourished or weak and
wants to rest. 2) Create a safe zone
around it and prevent dogs and crowds
from approaching it. 3) Call your local
marine stranding organization.

4) Take a location pin to share with the
rescuers. 5) After you have spoken to a
marine animal rescuer, and they request
you to collect the Penguin, follow their
instructions on how to handle it and where
to take it. Please be aware that they have
extremely sharp beaks and need to be
handled with care and cautiously.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU FIND A DOLPHIN

1) Check for any obvious injuries. 2)
Report to the local marine stranding organ-
ization and provide a detailed report of
condition and location. 3) Unless advised
by the stranding organization, do not
attempt to return the dolphin to the ocean.
Keep it cool by placing wet towels over it
and wetting the towels about every 10
minutes. 4) Reduce any stress from dogs
and crowds.

Plett Shark Spotters

It's that time of year again when we start keeping our eyes peeled for the arrival of white sharks in Plettenberg Bay! In 2024, our first sighting was in May, with activity peaking around September.

Robberg remains a truly special place one of the few spots where you can witness these apex predators cruising just metres from shore, right alongside the mountain. Recently, four white sharks were tagged along the east coast and eight in Mossel Bay. Shark Spotters are now operating daily from 07:00 to 18:00 at five beaches: Lookout Beach, The Wedge, Central Beach, Robberg 1, and The Wreck. Lifeguards will raise the white shark flag if a shark has been seen within the past hour.

NSRI Plett

A teenager injured on a hiking trail brought to safety.

Jaco Kruger, NSRI Plettenberg Bay station commander, said:

On Thursday, 1 May, at 11h56, NSRI Plett duty crew were activated following reports of a teenager injured on a hiking trail on the Salt River, Natures Valley.

Accompanied by his dad and mom, they are from Durbanville, the mom had hiked to a cell reception area to raise the alarm after her child was injured in a fall while hiking. Our NSRI crew responded to our NSRI Plettenberg Bay station 14 rescue base where the NSRI rescue craft Eric Stratford and Courtenay Rescuer were launched.

Med-Life ambulance services were activated to stand by at our NSRI rescue base. On arrival in the area, assisted by our Natures Valley community coast watchers, we negotiated entering the river mouth where upstream of the Salt River, at the first bend in the river, we found the family on the river banks. They were in the care of our Natures valley community coast watchers.

An NSRI doctor and our NSRI medics stabilised the teenager who was taken onboard our rescue craft, accompanied by his mom, and they were brought to our NSRI rescue base.

The dad arrived a bit later by car and the parents took their son to hospital.

The teenager is expected to make a full recovery.
