For Immediate Release Recycled Whale Artwork finds a home at Central Beach in Plettenberg Bay

The first Plettenberg Bay Recycling Art installation, started by Plett residents and former guesthouse owners, Fran and Dermot Molloy, has found a home at the

popular Central Beach!

Two years ago, the Molloy's spotted a similar 'Goby Fish' from Bali on social media, and this sparked their interest - "how can we copy this for Plett"? The objective behind the recycling project provides an interesting perspective to keeping our beaches clean and includes a strong message for us all to recycle. The idea is to create awareness about recycling and inspires us to protect our marine life and keep our beaches clean.

With the recent recognition of Plett as Africa's Leading Beach Destination with the World Travel Awards, the timing is perfect. In addition to creating awareness about recycling and sustainable environmental practices, the art installation also adds new

interest and a fresh perspective on art in the area.

"We love the innovation behind this project and are completely thrilled that the community has come together to make this happen. We are in the midst of a very difficult time for the hospitality industry and our local economy has taken strain. Putting this beautiful new art installation at the heart of the hospitality industry will enhance the beachfront and hopefully inspire us to look beyond what we believe to be possible and imagine a more vibrant and environmentally friendly world-class beach destination," says Patty Butterworth (CEO, Plett Tourism). Fran has been working with Alison Bryant from the Keep Plett Clean campaign to make this idea a reality. Natures Valley Trust (then headed up by Mark Brown) believed in the project and facilitated a grant through the Table Mountain Fund to get the ball rolling. They approached local artist and Fisanthoek Brewery owner, Derek Saul, with their concept, and he came up with an exciting initial design of a breaching humpback whale.

Fran engaged with key stakeholders who agreed to sponsor this project and worked hard to raise the necessary funds. The key stakeholders include Natures Valley Trust, Ocean Blue Adventures, Moby Dick's Restaurant, Sotheby's International Realty Plett, Crush Surf, Wine Roots, Fisanthoek Brewery, The Plettenberg Hotel, Health & Fitness Plett, Signtec, Stargate and numerous anonymous donors.

The Bitou Municipality built the base of the

installation, which will be covered by local mosaic artists during the upcoming Plett ARTS Festival in July. "A special thank you to Bitou Municipal representatives, which includes Councilor Dave Swart, Johnny Prins, Douglas Baartman and former employee Mark Fourie. We must not forget that many locals also made generous. smaller donations towards this project. Thank you to everyone for your donations, big or small - you know who you are!!" says Fran Molloy. She also adds, "Shortly after the project

started, the Coronavirus pandemic arrived and we all went into lockdown. This did not stop all parties involved, and they picked up the momentum in late 2020 as lockdown restrictions were eased. We are happy to say that this proudly Plett project has come to fruition and has been installed at Central Beach. It has been made using recycled metal, steel, confiscated fishing nets, lobster traps etc., and has been transformed into a giant sculpture of a breaching whale by Derek through blood, sweat, tears and total

passion."
The Plett artwork has been strategically placed at Central Beach to create awareness and to also create a focal point for one of Plett's most popular beaches. "Feed Me and Not the Sea" is the slogan. The unveiling will take place Saturday, 12 June at 12h00 just before the Plett ARTS Festival which takes place 10 - 20 July.

Natures Valley Trust conducted a competition to help find a special name for this magnificent whale sculpture in Plett

Recently I had a friend who read this snippet last week, and they asked why the word JOY is in capital letters each week. My answer is simple - in order to feel joy as a consistent state of being, regardless of perceived circumstances it is essential to Joy Own Yourself. This is based on both scientific and spiritual principles or truths and something my parents tried hard to teach me, but I see how good choices come from experience, which comes from bad choices. That is the route that I set out on, ignoring the sign posts my parents pointed out to me and I chose, often, to ignore. The result has been that I have gained experience from several disastrous choices! With time I find it so much easier to embrace this philosophy in all areas of my life. I admit that I still bump my head and discover dead ends and blind spots in various areas of life. As my children grow, I see similar ways in which my hard-earned advice is ignored and see the results in areas where they choose to ignore my advice. I now understand parental frustration on a new level! I remind myself that I did not expect my children to stand up and walk the fist day that they found the strength and compulsion to pull themselves up to standing. I appreciate that life is much like anything new - walking, riding a bike, driving a car - we learn at different speeds and in different ways. My children all walked at different ages. No matter how much I might have spoken to them about HOW to walk, they were not yet at a point where they could understand the "theory" and put it into practice. When I consider life from this perspective, I see how making choices and taking responsibility for the consequences is an integrated part of feeling joyous. We need to accept that our children will learn from what can be called "mistakes" or "lessons" – you

Duration of Game Drive 07h00 - 12h00 We enter the Park through the Addo Colchester Gate, Camp Matyholweni. The first few hours are good to see antelope, zebra and some of the cats. Between 09h00 and 09h30 we serve a delicious continental breakfast in the picnic area. Usually one has good sightings of elephants and buffalo after 10h00 nearer the waterholes. We return to the Gate around 12h00 and then back to the Guest House. Refreshments are available throughout the drive.

AFTERNOON GAME DRIVE

Collection from Guest House in Summer-Strand P.E between 13h00 - 13h30

Duration of Game Drive 14h00 - 18h00 We enter the Park through the Addo Colchester Gate, Camp Matyholweni. The early afternoon is good for elephant and buffalo sightings, near the water holes, as well as some antelope and zebra. We stop mid-afternoon at a disembarkment point or picnic area for teas, coffee, refreshments, scones and snacks. The latter part of the afternoon is usually good for antelope and the illusive rhino. The Park has thick bush and offers an abundance of birds, tortoise, dung beetles and other creatures.

A word fitly spoken is like APPLES OF GOLD

in a setting of silver-Proverbs 25v11

So we continue with our short series on the Fruits of the Spirit that we read about in Galatians 5:22-23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. This week we look at PEACE. When I think about peace, my mind immediately goes back to that glorious moment when the angel announced the birth of Jesus and the shepherds fearfully heard a multitude of heavenly host praising God and saying: Glory to God in the Highest, and on earth peace, goodwill to man. I think it is fair to say that the shepherds had no idea of how a baby born in Bethlehem could have anything to do with peace on earth. Nevertheless, if they were young shepherds, then 33 years later they would have understood as they witnessed the ultimate sacrifice. There was Jesus, nailed to a cruel cross, to become the substitute and pay the penalty for their sins and our sins today. They would also have seen Jesus alive again after his death and burial and through the grape vine become aware that He had left and gone back to heaven. They would have understood that it was clearly all a work of God... It had to Be!! But Why?? Because without the shedding of blood there can be no forgiveness of sin and without the forgiveness of sin there can be no peace. How can we have and make this peace our

own? Simply by believing on the Lord Jesus Christ as the one who paid for and saved us from our sins. Paul speaking to the Roman Christians said it so succinctly in Romans 5:1 Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. I remain humbled and deeply grateful for how wonderfully achievable God, in His immeasurable love, made it for any man or woman, from the highly regarded university professor to the lowliest of men to find this peace. God's Word, the Bible, makes it very clear that you cannot find this peace within yourself, you can only find it in Christ. Listen to the kind and loving words Jesus spoke to his disciples, then and now, in John 14:27 Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives.
