- Don't give out personal information on the phone, through the mail or over the internet unless you have initiated the contact or know whom you are dealing with.
- Verify if the representative posing on behalf of the company does indeed work at the company
- Criminals sometimes use the names of banks and their officials to give credibility to their "referrals" or support other aspects of their "to good-to-be-true" business proposals
- The offer may even be backed with impressive-looking documentation and letterheads, which may even be genuine, that have been stolen or reproduced.

- Once you are hooked, you will be asked to deposit money to help the transaction take place.
- If you make a deposit, you will never see the money again.
- Under no circumstances should you attempt to reply, either by email, phone or post.
- We urge you not to become another statistic in these scams.

Strandloper Project

Marine Wildlife Strandings in the Garden Route.

If, while enjoying your time on the beach and shoreline, you encounter a stranded species of marine wildlife, please contact your local Marine Stranding organization.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU FIND A TURTLE.

- 1) Do not return it to the ocean. It has stranded as it is either weak, ill, tired or has ingested plastic.
- 2) Do not place it in a container of water. Turtles are air breathing and can drown if weak and tired.
- 3) Keep it in a dry, ventilated and room temperature box, preferably placing the turtle on a towel.
- 4) Contact the turtle rescue number or the local marine stranding organization.
- 5) Get a location pin

WHAT TO DO IF YOU FIND A LIVE SEAL.

- 1) Do not try and chase it into the water - it is either tired, undernourished or weak and wants to rest.
- 2) Create a safe zone around it and prevent dogs and crowds from approaching it.
- 3) Call your local marine stranding organization.
- 4) Take a location pin to share with the rescuers.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU FIND A PENGUIN

- 1) Do not try and chase it into the water - it is either tired, undernourished or weak and wants to rest.
- 2) Create a safe zone around it and prevent dogs and crowds from approaching it.
- 3) Call your local marine stranding organization.
- 4) Take a location pin to share with the rescuers.

5) After you have spoken to a marine animal rescuer, and they request you to collect the Penguin, follow their instructions on how to handle it and where to take it. Please be aware that they have extremely sharp beaks and need to be handled with care and cautiously.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU FIND A DOLPHIN

- 1) Check for any obvious injuries.
- 2) Report to the local marine stranding organization and provide a detailed report of condition and location.
- 3) Unless advised by the stranding organization, do not attempt to return the dolphin to the ocean. Keep it cool by placing wet towels over it and wetting the towels about every 10 minutes.
- 4) Reduce any stress from dogs and crowds.

First Responders

On the 25th of January at approximately 08h25 First Responders were alerted to an MVA accident involving 2 vehicles on the N2 intersection of Beacon Way. Plettenberg Bay SAPS, Traffic Department, Bitou fire department and Ambulance services were alerted. First Responder volunteers responded to the scene in their private vehicles.

First Responder Brad said, "When I arrived on scene, I found 2 casualties who had sustained moderate injuries after their vehicles were involved in a side on collision."

The casualties were treated on scene for C Spine injuries and stabilised by first responders until handed over to Medlife and Metro Paramedics for transportation to hospital.

We wish both casualties a quick recovery.

First Responders is a community-based volunteer group who provides their assistance to the professional medical services. First Responder Volunteers fund their own fuel, phone, insurance etc.

We rely on donations from the public to fund our equipment and consumables.

The puma (*Puma concolor*) is known by various names across its extensive range, reflecting the diversity of cultures and regions it inhabits. Here are some of the common names for pumas:

Puma: This is one of the most widely used names for the species and is commonly used in North America.

Cougar: This name is often used in North America and refers to the species' ability to cover vast territories.

Mountain Lion: The term "mountain lion" is frequently used in North America, particularly in regions with mountainous terrain.

Panther: The term "panther" is used in some regions, but it can be confusing because it is also used for other big cats like leopards and jaguars.

Catamount: This name is used in some parts of North America, especially in historical contexts.

The National Treasury has accordingly created a registration and vetting platform for this purpose, the **Central Supplier Database (CSD)**, and all suppliers who intend doing business with the Bitou Municipality, must be registered on the CSD.

The benefits includes:

- The reduction of red tape and administrative effort when doing business with the Municipality.
- Compliance requirements will be easy to meet for suppliers that are in good standing with these requirements. The CSD will have interfaces to South African Revenue Service (SARS) to enable tax clearance status verification of suppliers throughout the Procure-to-Pay process as well as the Companies and Intellectual Property Commission (CIPC) for vetting of business registration and business ownership.
- **No proof of documentation is necessary. The CSD will electronically validate and authenticate all information.**
- **Your entity will be issued with a unique CSD number (MAAA.....), which must be used as a reference for future quotations, tenders and orders.**
- Eliminate duplication of compliance requirements and reduce duplication of effort and cost for both business and government.

NB! As from 1st July 2016 all suppliers who intends doing business with municipalities, must comply and be registered on this CSD. Please empower yourself and your company! That Bitou Municipality has embarked on a new eProcurement System with effect from 01 July 2023. THE SUPPLIERS AND SERVICE PROVIDERS, FOR GOODS AND SERVICES, WHICH ARE CURRENTLY REGISTERED ON THE NATIONAL TREASURY CENTRAL SUPPLIER DATABASE (CSD), MUST ENSURE THAT THEIR COMMODITIES ARE ALIGNED WITH THEIR TRADE COMMODITIES OF BUSINESS, i.e., A CATERING COMPANY MUST BE REFLECTED AS SUCH ON BOTH NATIONAL TREASURY CENTRAL SUPPLIER DATABASE (CSD) AND ON THE BITOU EPROCUREMENT SYSTEM.

This uniform Supply Chain Management system used right through all government institutions is essential to optimise the efficiency of service delivery. However, current legislation still demands that municipalities verify information such as the municipal accounts, vehicle registration and acceptability certificates (caterers) of suppliers. This is not included in the system because it does not apply to the National and Provincial Regulations. Therefore, unless these requirements are retracted, suppliers will still be vetted by municipalities in addition to the Central Supplier Database.
