


Angus John Anderson Greig 8 March 1947 - 13 May 2021

Our beloved father, Angus John Anderson Greig passed away on Thursday the 13th of May 2021 from heart failure. Fittingly it was Ascension Day. Despite all odds, he never left his beloved Ebenezer, clinging to this piece of land until his last moments.

Dad was born in Cape Town to Mavis and Peter Anderson Greig. Mavis was a Stellenbosch-born actress who trained at RADA in London and Peter was a London-born entrepreneur and businessman. Angus was their third child - he had two older sisters, Graine Auersperg (now deceased) and Gail Callie. Dad also has a brother, Andrew, who is ten years his junior. Peter and Mavis came to Plettenberg Bay in 1968, purchasing Ebenezer and Anath.

A few stand-out memories of Dad are:

 His devotion to his family. In the late nineties, Angus's mother took a turn for the worse and passed away. Angus moved down to Plettenberg Bay to look after his father and the running of Ebenezer. A great family friend - our neighbour and family doctor, Dr Peter Berning, remarked to





- Anglo (known as Ampros) who were determined to bring top-quality, international architecture to South Africa. He travelled over to Chicago with Tony Mason to engage with world-renowned architect Helmut Jahn. Collaborating with Helmut resulted in the revolutionary and iconic 'diamond building' - 11 Diagonal Street, and several other stunningly unique buildings. He was heavily involved in setting up the first Interior Design Degree in South Africa with Nottingham Trent University at the Design Center, Johannesburg with the respected Des Laubscher and was heavily involved with the Society of Designers in Southern Africa.
- He was a sensory man and immersed himself in life's pleasures. 'Greig's', he said, 'were built for comfort, not speed.' He also said that he advised always keeping one's stomach, 'in a constant state of surprise'. Pre-packed picnic baskets lined the passage at Ebenezer House, ready-to-go at a moment's notice, containing all the items prescribed in his ultimate picnic list of must-haves. One of these was a champagne cork muselet, because it turns out this is the most effective tool to have onboard to unblock some part of a clogged boat engine. Cold bubbly was always served in champagne glasses, whisky was imbibed up Whiskey Creek in crystal and there were the famous sundowners on Anath and then Robbberg Mountain.
- His love of art. I brought my land artist friends Anni Snyman and Strijdom van der Merwe to stay at Ebenezer to meet Dad for a potential land art project, and the rest is history. Our team spread so much joy bringing international artists to Plettenberg Bay producing incredible works and winning the prestigious Nedbank Business and Art South Africa (BASA) Arts and the Environment 'Award for the hugely supportive Tsogo Sun Beacon Island Hotel in 2012. My father was incredibly genérous with his time, cars, food and resources at his disposal. He will always remain the Handlanger, the LandArtLord and the team's An Goose. 'Focus Bliksem!' was our battle cry, as we consumed pretty disgusting boegoe brandy plotting our next land art moves around the kitchen table at Ebenezer.
- Angus's deep faith was his anchor throughout his life. His extensive collection of books on the scriptures was constantly referred to. He was an active Elder and Committee Member at St Columba's Presbyterian Church in Parkview, Johannesburg for much of his life, where for many years was the slightly terrifying Confirmation Class teacher. To add to his mystique the Confirmation classroom was situated in the top of the tower of the church and accessed via a teeny spiral staircase. Generations of teenagers quaked at his fearsome eyebrows. He regularly attended church on a Sunday morning at St Peter's Anglican Church in Plett and always sat in the first pew as it was where the lowest of the low were traditionally told to sit in the past.
- And lastly his crazy painted cars! The inspiration for this was the BMW Art Car Project which was introduced by the French racecar driver Hervé Poulain in 1975. Dad's cars have been made over for countless times by school children and great artists alike to take central roles in the land art events, festivals, processions and events. He even painted one of the Toyota Corolla's in glistening reflective thick yellow road paint to drive it to Johannesburg one year, and I distinctly remember being in the car watching fellow road users cautiously overtaking leaving a very wide berth around us staring at us intensely.

There was so much to Dad - his activism in the environmental arena, his constant seeking of knowledge and curiosity in any subject, his political activism as part of the PFP, the touching way he fed a hoard of stray and owned dogs on the farm each day, how he helped design churches for poorer communities, his involvement in the founding of Bay College on Ebenezer, his wonderful artistic ability.

In his immediate family, Dad leaves behind myself, my brother Murray, his wife Jacky and a grandchild Benjamin. He never recovered from the death of Murray's other son, Joshua Greig, who passed away aged two on the 22nd January 2021. Murray very nearly died a week later from the same cause - organophosphate poisoning, supposedly accidental. Unsurprisingly, after this massive shock Dad's already vulnerable body declined significantly.

His legend will live on! He touched so many with his kindness, his wonderful humour, his eccentricity and strong-headed individuality, his generosity, his curious and brilliant mind. He made a real difference to the world and leaves it a less colourful place.



Between 09h00 and 09h30 we serve a delicious continental breakfast in the picnic area. Usually one has good sightings of elephants and buffalo after 10h00 nearer the waterholes. We return to the Gate around 12h00 and then back to the Guest House. Refreshments are available throughout the drive.

AFTERNOON GAME DRIVE

Collection from Guest House in Summer-Strand P.E between 13h00 - 13h30

Duration of Game Drive 14h00 - 18h00 We enter the Park through the Addo Colchester Gate, Camp Matyholweni. The early afternoon is good for elephant and buffalo sightings, near the water holes, as well as some antelope and zebra. We stop mid-afternoon at a disembarkment point or picnic area for teas, coffee, refreshments, scones and snacks. The latter part of the afternoon is usually good for antelope and the illusive rhino. The Park has thick bush and offers an abundance of birds, tortoise, dung beetles and other creatures.




