

PUFFY VS NIGHTY



Snakes of Bitou

Snakes are one of the most misunderstood and feared animals on Earth... Here in Bitou we have a couple of dozen species of snakes, but only a few are considered medically significant.

And serious bites are quite rare... Traffic causes many more casualties than snakes! Snakes, like most animals, don't attack but only defend. It's quite simple: if you don't mess with a snake, it won't mess with you! Never handle a wild snake.

The current protocol for snakebites is: if possible photograph the snake, get the patient to a hospital ASAP. No other First Aid measures.

-Venomous snakes include: Puff adder (*Bitis arietans*), night adder (*Causus rhombatus*) and boomslang (*Dispholidus typus*). Boomslang are generally very shy and loathe to bite, and so bites from these snakes are very rare. Puff adders feature in most of the venomous snake bites in our area, as they are often attacked by dogs... Bites to humans are rare. Night adders are also responsible for some bites, requiring medical attention, but not life-threatening. Cape cobras (*Naja nivea*) and berg adders (*Bitis atropos*) are not very common...

-Semi-venomous snakes include: Herald (Red-lip) snake (*Crotaphopeltis hotamboeia*), spotted Skaapsteker (*Psammophylax rhombeatus*), many-spotted reed snake (*Amplorhinus multimaculatus*) and cross-marked grass snake (*Psammophis crucifer*). These snakes are of no medical importance, a bee-sting is more painful and

dangerous. But bites may cause swelling and pain. The most common species is the Herald snake.

-Non-venomous snakes include: Western green snake (*Philothamnus occidentalis*), brown house snake (*Boaedon capensis*), olive snake (*Elaeophis inornatus*), brown water snake (*Lycodonomorphus rufulus*), slug eater (*Duberria lutrix*) and mole snake (*Pseudaspis cana*).

Out of these snakes, only the mole snake is capable of giving a bite that might require stitches.

Snakes prey on rodents, frogs, lizards and even other snakes. They play a vital role in our ecosystems, and deserve respect and protection.

Golden Child is a mourning ritual for children aged 5–11 who have recently experienced a recent loss in their lives. Created by Belgian artist Barbara Raes, it has been performed 44 times since 2018. In Plettenberg Bay, six children will experience the ritual through a partnership between Born in Africa and Lunchbox Theatre. A child spends the night alongside a beautiful river with a trusted family member and the project leader. At dawn, the Sun Queen (played by Amanda Valela Ntantiso or Marveen Charles) wakes the child, saying she needs the light in child's eyes to help the sun rise. Together they set off on a magical boat journey, singing a mantra to welcome the sun as sorrow gently fades into the sea.

It's that time of year again when we start
keeping our eyes peeled ☺ for the arrival
of white sharks 🐬 in Plettenberg Bay! In
2024, our first sighting was in May, with
activity peaking around September ☑.
Robberg remains a truly special place 🏔,
one of the few spots where you can witness
these apex predators cruising just metres
from shore, right alongside the mountain.
Recently, four white sharks were tagged
along the east coast and eight in Mossel
Bay 🐬. Shark Spotters are now operating
daily from 07:00 to 18:00 at five beaches:
Lookout Beach, The Wedge, Central Beach,
Robberg 1, and The Wreck. Lifeguards will
raise the white shark flag 🏴 if a shark has
been seen within the past hour. 🐬



Strandloper Project

Marine Wildlife Strandings in the Garden Route.

If, while enjoying your time on the beach and shoreline, you encounter a stranded species of marine wildlife, please contact your local Marine Stranding organization.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU FIND A TURTLE.

1) Do not return it to the ocean. It has stranded as it is either weak, ill, tired or has ingested plastic. 2) Do not place it in a container of water. Turtles are air breathing and can drown if weak and tired. 3) Keep it in a dry, ventilated and room temperature box, preferably placing the turtle on a towel. 4) Contact the turtle rescue number or the local marine stranding organization.

5) Get a location pin.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU FIND A LIVE SEAL.

1) Do not try and chase it into the water - it is either tired, undernourished or weak and wants to rest. 2) Create a safe zone around it and prevent dogs and crowds from approaching it. 3) Call your local marine stranding organization.

4) Take a location pin to share with the rescuers.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU FIND A PENGUIN

1) Do not try and chase it into the water - it is either tired, undernourished or weak and wants to rest. 2) Create a safe zone around it and prevent dogs and crowds from approaching it. 3) Call your local marine stranding organization.

4) Take a location pin to share with the rescuers. 5) After you have spoken to a marine animal rescuer, and they request you to collect the Penguin, follow their instructions on how to handle it and where to take it. Please be aware that they have extremely sharp beaks and need to be handled with care and cautiously.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU FIND A DOLPHIN

1) Check for any obvious injuries. 2) Report to the local marine stranding organization and provide a detailed report of condition and location. 3) Unless advised by the stranding organization, do not attempt to return the dolphin to the ocean. Keep it cool by placing wet towels over it and wetting the towels about every 10 minutes. 4) Reduce any stress from dogs and crowds.


